Using MusicWriter with Your Hard Disk

Installing MusicWriter

A program is provided for users who want to run MusicWriter from a hard (or fixed) disk. This procedure will create a directory on the hard disk and load all relevant files to it. MusicWriter can be copied once and only once to a hard disk, and only by the procedure described below. Any attempt to copy files in any other way will make the copies non-executable.

This procedure requires you to provide a name for the new directory. If you want to use an existing directory, just enter the name of that directory in Step 3, and ignore the message about being unable to create the directory.

Follow the steps below to install MusicWriter on your hard disk.

1. Turn on the computer, with the door in Drive A open. (This assumes that you usually boot from your hard disk.)
2. When you see the **C >** prompt, insert the MusicWriter disk in Drive A, and close the drive door.
3. Type **A:SETFIXED NAME** where **NAME** is the name you have chosen for the new directory. The name must not be longer than eight characters.
4. When you press Enter, MusicWriter will install itself on the hard disk.

The system must be rebooted after this install. To do this, open the Drive A door and press Ctrl, Alt, and Del at the same time. To run MusicWriter after booting, type **CDNAME** where **NAME** is the new directory name. Press Enter. Then type **MUSICWTR** and press Enter.

Note: This install procedure will check the root directory for a file called **CONFIG.SYS**. If it is not there, the procedure will put it there. If it is there, it must be altered to include the line **DEVICE ANSL.SYS**. See your DOS manual's chapter on configuring.

Saving Music Files

Once you've installed MusicWriter on your hard disk, you can easily save music files to the same directory. When you are ready to save a music file, simply select **SAVE** from MusicWriter's main menu. Your music file will automatically be saved to the directory you created for MusicWriter.

IBM® PC/PCjr™/ Tandy® 1000 Reference Card

ENTERING NOTES

Press the key inside the brackets to enter a given note. For example, pressing 1 will put a whole note on the staff where the cursor is positioned. Use the top row of keys, not the numeric keypad, for entering note values.

[1] whole 

[2] half 

[4] quarter 

[8] eighth 

[6] sixteenth 

[3] thirty-second 

CURSOR MOVEMENT

[↑] up
[↓] down

[→] right

[←] left

[HOME] far left of staff

[PgDn] next staff

[PgUp] previous staff

[Ctrl-HOME] beginning of piece

[Ctrl-END] end of piece

[END] far right of staff

MODES

[F1] or [Ctrl]-[H] HELP MODE (displays on-screen information about using MusicWriter)

[F2] or [Ctrl]-[P] PLAY MODE (plays the entire piece)

[Alt]-[P] PLAY MODE (plays the current staff)

[F3] or [Ctrl]-[O] OPTIONS MODE (set tempo, tone-shaping options, or staves to be played)

[F4] or [Ctrl]-[B] BLOCK MODE (copy, delete, or transpose passages)

[F5] or [Ctrl]-[T] TIME MODE (set or check time signature)

[F6] or [Ctrl]-[K] KEY MODE (select key)

[F7] or [Ctrl]-[S] SLUR MODE (slur all notes)

KEYPRESSES IN EDIT MODE

[.] dot	[{} first ending
[/] tie	[}] second ending
[R] rest	[Shift/P] piano (softer)
[F] flat	[Shift/F] forte (louder)
[#] sharp	[H] octave higher (current voice)

IBM PC/Tandy 1000

6 voices
Notes sound as shown
Requires a music board
Drums available

PCjr/Tandy 1000

3 voices
Notes sound an octave higher
Does not require a music board
Drums not available

Note: The Tandy 1000 can act as a PC or PCjr. Without the Mindscape Music Board, the Tandy 1000 plays three musical voices like the PCjr. With the Mindscape Music Board, the Tandy 1000 plays six musical voices like the PC.
