


Chapter 1

THE 256KZ AND 1024KZ IN A 68000 SYSTEM

INTRODUCTION

The Cromemco $10\,24\mathrm{KZ}$ and $25\,6\mathrm{KZ}$ memory boards provide S-100 bus systems with 1 megabyte and 256 kilobytes, respectively, of high-speed random access memory (RAM).

Both the 1024KZ and the 256KZ are 16-bit memory boards, and both are compatible with Cromemco's 68000-based central processors, the DPU and the XPU. Unlike the 1024KZ, the 256KZ is also compatible with Cromemco's Z80-based central processor, the ZPU. The 256KZ can be configured either as four 64-Kbyte banks of memory in a Z80 system (refer to chapter 2), or as 256 Kbytes of contiguous memory in a 68000 system.

Table 1-1 lists the operational specifications of the 1024KZ and the 256KZ.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Refer to your system manual for instructions on adding new circuit boards. Before installing the 256KZ and 1024KZ boards, their switches must be set so that each board is assigned a unique place in the 68000 processor's 16 megabyte address space. There are no cables or jumper settings required.

Switch Settings




Figure 1-1: 256KZ SWITCH SETTINGS

256KZ - Switch settings for 256KZ boards in a 68000 system are shown in figure 1-1. Note that switch 1 on the 256KZ board, which enables the bottom 32 Kbytes of memory on power-up or reset, is ON only for the first 256KZ.




Figure 1-2: 1024KZ SWITCH SETTINGS

1024KZ - Switch settings for 1024KZ boards are shown in figure 1-2.

If you have a combination of 256 KZ and 1024 KZ boards, refer to table 1-2 for the appropriate switch settings (1 = ON, 0 = OFF).

Chapter 2

THE 256KZ IN A Z80 SYSTEM

In a Z80 Cromix system, the 256KZ is the logical equivalent of four 64-Kbyte boards. The bank-select PROM in IC39 determines the bank number assigned to each 64-Kbyte segment.

With a DPU (or XPU) central processor board, you can run the Z80 and 68000 Cromix (or Cromix-Plus) Operating Systems interchangeably, without changing the switch settings on the 256KZ. The 256KZ automatically switches from contiguous memory in a 68000 system to bank selected memory in a Z80 system. During Z80 operations data is transferred in bytes (8 bits), and during 68000 operations data is transferred in words (16 bits).

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Refer to your system manual for instructions on adding new circuit boards. Before installing the 256KZ in a Z80 system, switch 1 must be set correctly (switches 2 through 7 are irrelevant to Z80 operations), and IC39 must have the correct bank-select PROM for your system configuration.

3-User Systems




Figure 2-1: THE 256KZ IN Z80 CROMIX SYSTEMS

A 3-user Z80 Cromix system requires only one 256KZ board. As shipped, the 256KZ has a 3-user PROM (part number 502-0047) already installed in IC39 that fills banks 0 through 3 with memory, and maps banks 4 through 6 to bank zero. Switch 1, which enables the bottom 32 Kbytes of memory on power-up or reset, must be ON (see figure 2-1).

6-User Systems

A 6-user Z80 Cromix system requires two 256KZ boards. Remove the factory-installed PROM in IC39 from both boards. On the first board, install a 6-user PROM for banks 0 through 3 (part number 502-0048) in IC39, and set switch 1 to the ON position (see figure 2-1). On the second board, install a 6-user PROM for banks 4 through 6 (part number 502-0049) in IC39, and set switch 1 to the OFF position.

256KZ and 64KZ-II

For a 4-user Z80 Cromix system composed of one $256 \rm KZ$ and one $64 \rm KZ$ -II, install a 4-user PROM in IC39 (part number 502-0050). For a 5-user system with one $256 \rm KZ$ and two $64 \rm KZ$ -II boards, install a 5-user PROM in IC39 (part number 502-0051). In both cases, set switch 1 on the $256 \rm KZ$ board to the ON position.






