- (IS) Denotes Information Separator, a character which separates and qualifies information in a logical sense. These characters are used in alhierarchical order.
- FS1 Reserved with System 21 for an End-of-VIAtape (EVT) control character.
- DEL2 Delete is used primarily to "erase" or "obliterate" erroneousor unwanted characters in perforated tape. In a strict sense, DEL is not a control character.
