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Introduction

Overhead Express is designed with two editors, Express and Custom. Twelve templates and a limited number of layout and design commands are available through the Express Editor. The full range of layout and design commands is available through the Custom Editor. You can type in commands directly or work through a series of menus. In order to access Overhead Express, type OE.

• Program Defaults

There are default settings for a number of commands in the program. These settings will take effect in your presentations unless you: (1) use the configure program to change these defaults (with the exception of measurement units, which must remain in dots) or (2) use commands to override defaults on a single page.

• Dot Commands

Dot commands control instructions that stay in effect for more than a single line. You can use dot commands only in the Custom Editor. Enter dot commands only at the beginning of a line. Text should not be put on the same line. When typing in dot commands, the correct abbreviation is the first two letters of the command name. When typing in arguments, leave a blank space between arguments.

• Backslash Commands

Backslash commands control adjustments within lines. You can use backslash commands in both the Express and Custom Editors. Backslash commands are interspersed with text, at the point in the line where the backslash command is to have its effect. When typing in backslash commands, the correct abbreviation is the first letter only of the command name. Do not leave space between the complete command and the text. Backslash commands remain in effect until the line ends or until the same command is issued again.

• Files

Names assigned to Overhead Express files must not be longer than eight characters and must follow standard DOS format. It is not necessary to enter Overhead Express file name extensions. The program automatically assigns the following extensions:

.BDY font file

.KEY font file
.TEM template

.PRE presentation file

.BAK backup presentation file



Overhead Express has been designed with 12 templates that help you quickly prepare overhead transparencies. All templates are available through F3 Build in both the Express and Custom Editors.





• Fonts

Overhead Express offers four typefaces: Classic, Popular, Script, and Modern. Classic, Popular, and Script have three sizes and Modern has five sizes. All fonts are measured in dots. Each font (except Script) comes in regular and italic styles. In addition to the 26 letters of the alphabet, each font contains the numerals zero through nine, international characters, and various punctuation marks. A special symbol font is also available in two sizes. See your User Guide for more font illustrations.


